- Biblical Example: Nehemiah. Nehemiah 2:6; 2:11-18. Nehemiah does research, gets the facts, uses logic to see what's going on, organizes a plan, and accomplishes the task of rebuilding the wall.

PERSISTER

- Strengths: Dedicated, observant, conscientious
- Viewpoint: Evaluating first lens - able to make judgment calls on the spot
- Motivator: Needs recognition or beliefs and opinions
- % of U.S. Population: 10%; 25% female, 75% male
- Biblical Example: Paul. Philippians 3:4-9. Verse 8: Paul explains his viewpoint with strong opinions.

DREAMER

- Strengths: Imaginative, calm, reflective, easy going
- Viewpoint: Reflecting first lens - imagines and conceptualizes in special ways
- Motivator: Needs private time and personal space; externally motivated
- % of U.S. Population: 10%; 60% female, 40% male
- Biblical Example: Mary, the mother of Jesus. Luke 1:26-31; 2:16-19. She ponders and reflects on what the situation may be, and treasures things in her heart.

CATALYZER

- Strengths: Adaptive, persuasive, charming
- Viewpoint: Action first lens
- Motivator: Needs excitement and opportunities to make things happen; Carpe Diem
- % of U.S. Population: 5%; 40% female, 60% male
- Biblical Example: Rahab. Joshua 2:4-6, 8-10, 12-16. Rahab senses danger, takes action, takes risks and gets it going.

ENERGIZER

- Strengths: Spontaneous, creative, playful
- Viewpoint: Reacting first lens - responds in strong likes and dislikes
- Motivator: Needs playful contact and humor; has a unique ability to enjoy life and have fun
- % of U.S. Population: 20%; 60% female, 40% male
- Biblical Example: Peter. John 13:3-9. Peter reacts with a strong dislike and then a strong like.
