Even when I am old and gray, do not forsake me, my God, till I declare your power to the next generation.' As we reflect on the impact our church has had in the community, how can we, as ministers of reconciliation, more intentionally share the gospel with the next generation and those outside the church?

- 4. Have someone recap the message in about a minute or two and then ask the following questions: Looking at your sermon notes, what statements or questions were you most challenging or encouraging?
- 5. The sermon celebrated the work of God by highlighting the growth over the past two Cultivate campaigns. What is most exciting to you about being a part of a growing church? How can you go about making the church feel smaller or more intimate?

6. Read Eph 3:20-21. The sermon highlighted plans, goals, and ministry expansion options for '25/'26 the elders are prayerfully considering and inviting you to partner with them in prayer. Take some time as a life group to ask God to give them the wisdom they need regarding these plans. If possible, carve out some time to write to the elders and let them know you are praying for them as they seek God's guidance.

7. Read Matthew 6:9-13 as prayer then begin to reflect on your life over the years. In hindsight, write down how you have seen God work in your life with regard to Matthew 6:9-13. Go verse by verse giving praise and celebrate how you have seen God in each of those ways. Finish by singing or simply listening to the song "Holy Forever" by Chris Tomlin. Share how this time was with your group.
