Grow (10-20 mins)

2. Last week we challenged you to set aside some time to Sabbath. Share about your experience of slowing down and recharging in the Lord from last week or ways you want to try for this week.

- 3. Read Hebrews 1:1-4. What was most meaningful to you from this week's message? What questions do you have about the person and work of Jesus after starting the book of Hebrews?
- 4. Have someone in your group summarize the 3 ways in which God has revealed Himself to mankind.

Special Revelation: Scripture

Better Revelation: His Son! The Gospel, Jesus incarnate, fully God and fully man

Which of these have been most significant to you? Can you share about a time you've experienced God's presence through one of the three ways He has revealed Himself to you?

5. We covered a big doctrine this week known as "<u>Hypostatic Union</u>". Why is it important we understand that Jesus is fully God AND fully man? How does this doctrine affect your daily walk with Jesus?

Practice: Celebrating the Work of God

7. Read this section of the Nicene Creed outloud in your time together:

"We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of one being with the Father.

Through him all things were made. For us men and for our salvation he came down from heaven; by the power of the Holy Spirit He became incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and was made man. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate; He suffered death and was buried.

On the third day he rose again in accordance with the scriptures; he ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and his kingdom will have no end."

Pray and meditate over the supernatural statements said about Him one at a time. What do we come to understand about God and His character through Christ as the better revelation? In what ways did your view of Jesus grow bigger after reading the creed, passage, and listening to the sermon? End in prayer, thanking Him for what He has revealed through Jesus Christ.
