A Better Worship

Connect (15-20 mins)

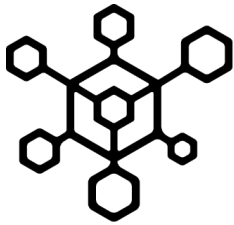

2. What has stood out the most to you so far through this series of Hebrews? In what ways has that impacted your day to day since? What perspectives have changed that influence your heart, soul, mind, and strength as you walk with God?

Share (45-60 mins)

3. Our relationship with God before Christ, could be described as “at a distance” because of sin, we could not draw near to Him. Understanding Jesus as our High Priest, who entered the Most Holy Place once for all with His own blood, how does it change the way you approach God? What still makes God feel distant at times — and what helps you draw near to Him with confidence?
4. The old system of worshipping God involved sacrifices that were imperfect and temporary in dealing with sin. Hebrews 9:14 says that Christ’s blood “cleanses our consciences from acts that lead to death, so that we may serve the living God”. Where do you see God actively renewing your inner life—not just your behavior, but your motives, desires, and identity?
5. We can live in a better worship today because of the fact that Jesus represents us to be near to the Father, even more so that His Spirit is sealed within us giving us direct access. We don’t have to worship because of guilt and shame, rather we worship because of our relationship with him. How does our relationship in Christ influence our lives as a spiritual act of worship (Romans 12:1-2)?
6. If the tabernacle once symbolized God’s presence among His people, and now through Christ and the Holy Spirit, we have become His dwelling place, how should this truth shape the way we live, think, and treat others? Is there a situation where you live, work, or play that this truth would change how you might respond to or interact with others?
